

TOURISM SANITATION GUIDANCE

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

This guideline should be used by tourism partners that operate a public transport vehicle in the Cayman Islands. The guide seeks to address the following areas for consideration for implementation.

2	Queuing	Persons congregated together before onboarding at bus stop	Signage displays at bus stops indicating that persons waiting for the bus should be 6ft apart	Facemasks or cloth face coverings must be worn while queuing. Hand sanitizer suggested to be used at each bus stop.	PTU	At all times
3	Bus Depot	Queuing and social distancing at bus depot	Persons must adhere to social distancing of 6ft apart when waiting for a bus.	Signage to be displayed at bus depot along with hand sanitizer.	PTU	At all times

4	Facemask requirement	All operators and passengers	All operators and passengers to wear a mask or cloth face coverings.	Face masks to be provided to PTU staff. Operator and Passenger to provide own mask or cloth face covering.	PTU	At all times Operator has the right to refuse passengers who refuse to wear a mask or cloth face covering.
5	Prior to entering vehicle	Vehicle cleanliness	Vehicle to be wiped down with 70% alcoholic wipes. All high-touch hard surfaces, seats, seat belts and dashboard to be wiped down.	Every public transport operator to clean vehicle pre and post shift and note in log (if applicable).	Operator	At all times
6	Passengers in vehicle	Number of passengers within the vehicle	All public transport must operate with a maximum of 50% occupancy to maintain social distancing	Hand sanitizer suggested to be carried by operators and passengers. Staggered seating required.	Operator	At all times
7	Handling of luggage	Door handle and luggage handles	Trunk of vehicle wiped down with 70% alcohol wipes or spray, hand sanitizer used by operator and passenger.	All operators and passengers to use hand sanitizer.	Operator	At all times
8	Entrance into vehicle	Door handles	Signage in vehicle and hand sanitizer	All operators and passengers to use	Operator	At all times

9	Payment	Electronic payment for ride	All customers to pay via electronic system.	Hand sanitizer used by operator and passengers. Machine wiped down by operator after every use.	Operator	At all times
10	Payment	Cash payment for ride	All passengers to use hand sanitizer before paying for ride. Exact change is required.	Operator to use hand sanitizer after each transaction.	Operator	At all times
11	Exit of vehicle	Door handles and vehicle	Operator suggested to exit vehicle first, use hand sanitizer, wipe down door handle and open door.	Hand sanitizer used by operator and passenger.	Operator	At all times
12	Public Transport operators	Sick operators reporting to drive/work	Operator cannot report to work if ill.		PTU	At all times
13	Public Transport operators	Training on sanitation measures	PTU will provide training on sanitation measures	PTU will provide training completion notice.	PTU	Ongoing
