

VISITS:

The Cayman Islands received **180,624 stay-over visits** in the first nine months of 2022.

- Visits for the first nine months of 2022 was 47% of 2019 visitation for the same reference period
- · Visitation is **trending upwards** as traveller confidence returns.
- Visits in September 2022 were 74% of September 2019, showing vast improvements from January when visits were 14% of 2019. Year-to-date figures show that visits were 47% of the same period in 2019.
- · Visits peaked in **July** with **32,356 persons**.





PURPOSE OF VISIT:

Leisure Visits accounted for **87.4%** of all visits. **Visiting Relatives** and **Business Travel** followed by **7.3%** and **4.1%**, respectively.

• Persons journeying to the destination to visit relatives reached 61% of 2019. Business travel was 30% of the pre-pandemic level.

THE UNITED STATES made up 81.7% of all stay-over visits to the Cayman Islands, equating to 147,597 trips.

This was 2.6 percentage points (pp) lower than in 2019.

- · Canada accounted for 6.1% of visits (0.4pp higher than 2019).
- Europe accounted for 6.0% of visits (1.5pp higher than 2019).



INBOUND AIRLINE SEATS to the Cayman Islands for the first nine months of 2022 was 66% of January to September 2019 airlift.

- Inbound seats in the **third quarter of 2022 was 82% of the third quarter of 2019**. In the first quarter of 2022, the airlift was 45% of the same period in 2019.
- Based on October to December 2022 airline schedules, inbound airline seats are expected to be 94% pre-pandemic level. STR Inc reported that the average daily rate of hotel rooms in the Cayman Islands returned to the pre-pandemic level in the second quarter of 2022 and remained above 2019 rates in the third quarter of 2022.

CRUISE TOURISM:

There were 140 cruise ship calls, with 426,293 passengers between March and September 2022.

- Year-to-date cruise passenger arrivals represent 23% of 2019 arrivals.
- Passenger arrivals peaked in June with 89,868 passengers. This was 86% of June 2019 passenger arrivals.










STAY-OVER VISITATION


INBOUND AIRLINE CAPACITY (JAN-SEP) 6% OF 2019
